### Why Are Fan Access Ports so Important?

Access ports on a exhaust fans are important because they help increase the fan's lifespan and allow for proper cleaning and inspection.

- Without even cleaning the fan's rotation is thrown off balance and this creates uneven wear and tear; decreasing fan lifespan.
- Without an access port complete inspection of the fan is impossible.
- It's the Law!



### Fire Code NFPA 96 code 8.1.5.3.2 states:

"On existing upblast fans where sufficient access is not available to allow for the removal of grease contamination, an approved hinge mechanism or **access panel shall be installed.**" *(emphasis supplied)*
